

HOUSE EVENT REGULATIONS ALPIN TEAM AUSTRIA

ALPIN TEAM TRAILRUN

1. General rules

All areas of the Alpin Team Trailrun event are subject to the regulations of the organiser. We explicitly point out that all persons entering the entire ATT (festival) area, car park, WC, showers and the after-race party agree to these regulations and are obliged to follow the instructions of the designated staff.

There are no special regulations for children!

In this context, parents are fully responsible for any damage to equipment and persons. The organiser is exempt from any liability.

2. General sound and effects

The organiser points out that the starting signal (K50 - 07:00, K23 - 11:00) is given by means of a "bang". This bang is comparable to a cannon shot and can lead to hearing loss or similar injuries. The organiser emphasises the need for an appropriate safety distance.

Fog cannons and spray fountains are used at all starts and finishes. A safety distance of at least 1.5 metres must be maintained. It should also be noted that the sound system and moderation will be at a considerable volume. It should be noted that the organiser assumes no liability for personal injury or material damage in connection with the general sound and effects on the entire race day and beyond. Therefore, the organiser shall be indemnified and held harmless in court.

3. Images and advertising material

The organiser points out that photos, film recordings and interviews made in connection with the Alpin Team Trailrun may be used in radio, television, advertising, books, photomechanical reproduction - films, video cassettes etc. - without any claims to compensation. All persons entering the event site are hereby informed of this policy and waive all data protection rights to their own image.

4. Line-up area

The line-up area is only accessible to registered participants and official ATT personnel. Therefore, only those in possession of a valid race bib are permitted to be in this closed-off area. The exclusion of liability applies in this area. Persons who enter this area and thus violate the organiser's regulations are not entitled to any compensation or similar compensation. The organizer assumes no liability for the line-up area and is to be held harmless within the scope of the liability disclaimer.

Furthermore, the organiser points out that the Schöntalstraße is officially closed, which is indicated by a no driving sign and a barrier fence. Despite all the precautionary measures taken, the organiser cannot guarantee that the driving ban will be observed. Therefore, no liability is assumed for persons and material in this context.

Please also note that setting foot on the winner's bridge and the red carpet is at your own risk. It is not permitted to cross the finish line with a child below 18 years of age and does not have a valid race bib. All participants are obliged to leave the line-up area as soon as possible after arrival. After leaving the area, the organiser is also not liable for personal injury or material damage.

5. Safety

Backpacks and large bags may not be left in the start and finish areas. The use of bicycles, scooters or similar means of transport is not permitted. In the event of a medical emergency, please contact the medical staff. The admission protocol of the rescue service must be filled out correctly and completely! We would like to point out that it is forbidden to enter the entire event site barefoot.

6. Further guidelines

We would like to point out that the organiser cannot be held liable for injuries of any kind. This disclaimer of liability extends to all areas that can be associated with the Alpin Team Trailrun!

We would further like to explicitly emphasise the following points for which the organiser and all helpers cannot be held liable:

- Start and finish area incl. line-up area
- Spectator area
- Car park
- WC and shower facilities
- After race party
- Inflatable castle or similar amusement facilities
- Power failures and consequential damage to persons and material

- Injuries caused by broken glass or alike
- Fire damage to persons and material
- Severe weather conditions such as: wind, rain, hail, storm or similar
- Damage to persons or their property in all areas
- Loss of possessions

Environmental protection:

Do not leave any rubbish in the start and finish area.
Use the rubbish bin provided for this purpose.

Timetable and start preparation:

Observe the official timetable and arrive on time for race briefing and line-up.
Follow the instructions for the line-up.

Award ceremony:

The award ceremony will take place in a timely manner.
Respect the winners, your fellow human beings and the event.

Communication:

For information and updates on the event, use the official communication channels of the organiser.

Emergency plan:

In the event of an emergency or evacuation, follow the instructions of the ATT personnel.

Sanctions:

Violations of these house rules may lead to disqualification or other sanctions.

Legal notice:

The organiser is obliged to display and signpost these house rules.

The organiser would like to point out once again that, as expressed in point 1, all persons entering the ATT (festival) area fully agree to these house rules and that the organiser is to be indemnified and held harmless in court or by the authorities!

Please observe these rules to ensure the smooth running of the event and the safety of all participants. Thank you for your participation and wish you a successful and safe running event.
