HOUSE EVENT REGULATIONS ALPIN TEAM AUSTRIA ALPIN TEAM TRAIL



1. General Rules

All areas of the Alpin Team Trail are subject to the organizer's regulations. We explicitly point out that all persons entering the entire ATT (festival) area, the parking lot, the toilet facilities, the showers, and the after-race party location agree to these regulations and are obliged to follow the instructions of the designated staff.

There are no special regulations for children!

In this context, parents are fully responsible for any damage to property or injury to persons. The organizer is exempt from any liability.

General Sound and Effects

The organizer points out that the starting signal (K50 - 6:30 a.m., K23 - 10:00 a.m., K10 - 10:30 a.m.) will be given by means of a "bang." This bang is comparable to a cannon shot and can cause hearing loss or similar injuries. The organizer emphasizes the need to maintain a proper safety distance.

Smoke cannons and spray fountains will be used at all start and finish lines. Spectators must maintain a safety distance of at least 1.5 meters. It should also be noted that the music and commentary will be played at a considerable volume. It should be noted that the organizer assumes no liability for personal injury or property damage in connection with the general sound system and effects throughout the entire race day and beyond. Therefore, the organizer shall be held harmless and indemnified in court.

3. Images and Advertising Material

The organizer points out that all photos, film recordings and interviews made in connection with the Alpin Team Trail may be used in radio, television, advertising, books, social media, photomechanical reproduction - films, video cassettes, etc. - without any claims for remuneration. All persons entering the event site are hereby informed of this policy and agree to the use of the resulting image material by the organizer.

4. Line-Up Area

The line-up area is accessible exclusively to registered participants and official ATT staff. Therefore, only those in possession of a valid race bib are permitted to remain in this closed-off area. The exclusion of liability applies in this area. Unauthorized persons who are present within this closed-off area and thus violate the organizer's regulations are not entitled to any compensation for damages or similar compensation. In accordance with the disclaimer, it is the responsibility of the organizer to be indemnified and held harmless in court and by the competent authorities.

Furthermore, the organizer points out that Schöntalstraße in 5453 Werfenweng is officially closed to traffic, which is indicated by a no-entry sign and a barrier. Despite all the precautions taken, the organizer cannot guarantee that the traffic ban will be observed. Therefore, no liability is accepted for persons and/or material in this context.

Please note that the disclaimer applies to the entire start and finish area.

The organizer expressly points out that entering the victory ramp, the red carpet, or similar facilities is at your own risk. Crossing the finish line with a child who is not at least 18 years old and cannot provide a valid race number is not permitted. All participants are required to leave the start and finish areas as quickly as possible after arrival. After leaving the area, the organizer is also not liable for personal injury or property damage.

5. Safety

Backpacks and larger bags may not be left in the start and finish areas. The use of bicycles, scooters, or similar means of transportation is not permitted.

The organizer points out that beach flags, finish arches, or similar items may fall over due to wind or a power failure and could hit people. No liability is assumed in this regard.

In the event of a medical emergency, please contact the medical staff. The patient treatment protocol of the rescue service must be completed correctly and completely!

We would like to point out that walking barefoot on the entire event site is prohibited.

6. Further Guidelines

We would like to point out that the organizer accepts no liability for injuries of any kind. This liability disclaimer applies to the entire Alpin Team Trail - specifically: the start and finish area, the spectator area, the parking lot, the toilet and shower facilities, and the after-race party location. Use of all facilities provided is at your own risk. Entering the bouncy castle is also at your own risk.

The organizer would like to point out once again the following points, where no claims for damages of any kind can be asserted:

• Power failures and consequential damage to persons and property

- Cuts from broken glass or similar injuries
- Fire damage to persons and property
- Damage caused by wind, storm, hail, or similar weather conditions
- Injuries of any kind
- Damage to persons or their property in the parking lot
- Damage to persons and property in the toilet and shower facilities
- Damage to persons and property in connection with the entire after-race party
- Loss of property
- Damage to persons or property inside and outside the bouncy castle

Environmental protection:

Do not leave any trash in the start and finish areas. Use the trash cans provided for this purpose The event promotes waste separation. Please separate your waste correctly into the designated trash cans

For information and updates on the event, use the official communication channels of the organiser

Emergency plan:

In the event of an emergency or evacuation, follow the instructions of the ATT staff

Sanctions:

Violations of these house rules may lead to disqualification or other sanctions

Legal notice:

The organiser is obliged to display and signpost these house rules.

The organiser would like to point out once again that, as expressed in point 1, all persons entering the ATT (festival) area fully agree to these house rules and that the organiser is to be indemnified and held harmless in court or by the authorities!
